We only use timber supplied by companies accredited by the Programme for the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC), meaning that all of our timber-based materials come from sustainable sources. At its end of life, all of our furniture can be recycled, incinerated, or composted. Our manufacturing processes have been refined to lessen any impact on the environment including the use of optimising programmes to achieve the highest yield from our sheet materials. We have also partnered with Timberpak Ltd. which means all of our timber off-cuts can be re-processed into new sheets of MFC. Any excess and extracted dust can then be put into our wood-burning incinerator which we use to heat the factory. Our commitment to the environment extends to recycling 95% of our factory's waste materials and opting for reusable and/or biodegradable packaging alternatives where possible.
